Dogwood Crossing, Miles has recently produced an in-house curated exhibition Habitat: Environmental Art of the Darling Downs.

Habitat draws together the work of over 30 Australian artists and scientists who have responded to and studied the natural environment of the Darling Downs, south-east Queensland, from the late nineteenth century to the present day.
